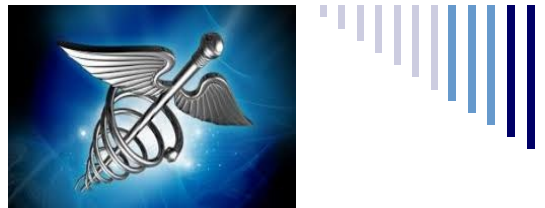
PURPOSE:

The primary goal of the *Covenant Connections Home Care (CCHC)* is to promote healing of acute and chronic wounds for our patients. We also strive to set up cost-effective wound management programs and educate our patients, their families, and other caregivers about treatment options and measures to prevent wound recurrences.



WOUND EVALUATION:

Our staff takes a complete health history, determines the cause of the wound, and examines any existing health factors that may affect the wound-healing process. Each patient's wounds and wound areas are then thoroughly assessed, measured, and photographed to help track the progress of wound healing



PLAN OF CARE:

The CCHC team develops a plan of care specific to each patient's needs, living situations, lifestyles, and other factors. The team collaborates with the patient's primary care or referring physician and other services – such as a visiting nurse or home health aide – as well as family members or caregivers to help ensure that the patient receives appropriate care at home.



EDUCATION:

The CCHC staff helps educate patients and their families in the fundamentals of basic wound care. We can teach caregivers how to perform the wound care and show them how to use the products we've chosen for that wound. We will help patients understand how modifying their lifestyle can help the healing process. We also discuss with patients and their families any additional treatment options that might be helpful.

INFECTION MANAGEMENT:

Using wound, tissue and blood cultures and/or biopsies, we will diagnose the causes of infections and prescribe the appropriate medications or treatment options.
